Boerne Performing Arts will operate as a committee functioning under the auspices of the Hill Country Council for

the Arts, a 501(c)3 non-profit organization whose primary mission is to develop and sustain a cultural environment that supports and promotes awareness, appreciation, education and public access to all arts in Boerne, Kendall County and the Texas Hill Country.
