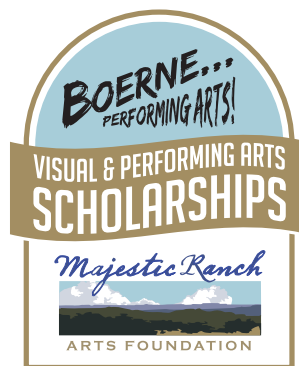


SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION & CRITERIA



Boerne Performing Arts and Majestic Ranch Arts Foundation are pleased to announce an annual scholarship program that will benefit local students who are pursuing careers in the fine arts.

Promoting all aspects of a fine arts program, the awards will each be in the amount of \$5,000.

The two fine arts awards are:

VISUAL ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria to be considered for these scholarships is as follows:

- Student must be in their senior year of high school (2018-2019), planning to pursue a degree in Fine Arts at a college, university or fine arts school.
- Student must be a resident of OR attending high school in the following counties: Kendall, Bandera, Gillespie
- Student must be accepted and enrolled in a fine arts program at a college, university or fine arts school in the fall of 2019.
- Students must submit the following for consideration:
 - Completed application form (*3 pages*)
 - High School Transcripts (*Attachment 1*)
 - One page typed bio (*Attachment 2*)
 - Two Letters of Recommendation (*Attachments 3-4*)
 - Present a jury of artwork (visual arts scholarship) or Perform an audition (performing arts scholarship)
- All winners selected by the Boerne Performing Arts Scholarship Committee will be final.
- The scholarships are non-renewable.
- All scholarship checks will be mailed directly to the college, university or fine arts school. The scholarship winner must provide proof of enrollment to Boerne Performing Arts for the check distribution process to begin.
- It is the responsibility of the applicant to complete all required materials by the deadlines.

Completion of two parts will be required to be considered for the scholarship.

1. Part I: Application Form. (Due March 15, 2019)
2. Part II: Audition/Jury. (March 23, 2019)

All applicants will be notified of the scholarship winners within one week following Part II of the application.

PART ONE:

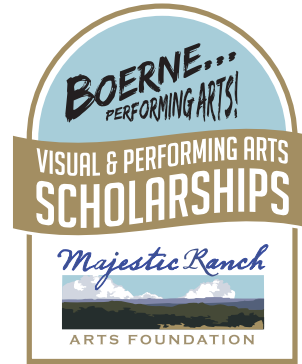
VISUAL ARTS APPLICANTS:

- Jury set-ups will begin at 9:00am. Students are allocated 60 minutes total time for set-up of their artwork.
- Artwork display should include a minimum of three varied examples representative of their artwork. Contrasting artwork is encouraged that will demonstrate various elements of artistic expression.
- The following will be provided for each student: table with a black tablecloth.
- Please arrive promptly at 9:00am to receive your maximum set-up time.
- Judges will view artwork from 10:00am – 11:00am.
- Artwork must be removed from 11:00am – 12:00noon.
- If your specific discipline has not been addressed, please contact Boerne Performing Arts (info@BoernePerformingArts.com or 830.331.9079) for clarification.

PERFORMING ARTS APPLICANTS:

- Auditions will begin at 9:30am. Students are allocated 15 minutes total time for set-up and performance.
- Students will be notified of their individual audition time by email or by phone no later than five days prior to the audition.
- Audition performances should include two contrasting movements or selections, each a minimum of 2 minutes in length. Students are encouraged to perform by memory, but it is not required.
- The following will be provided for each student: chair, music stand, piano, and CD player.
- Students must provide their own accompaniment (either a pianist or a CD) if one is written.
- Please arrive prior to your assigned audition time. A warm-up room for your use will be available 15 minutes prior to your audition.
- Please bring three copies of your music for the judges (with measures numbered).

2. Details of your current and past studies in the Fine Arts (i.e. years of study, art disciplines you have studied, instruments you play, type of singing, forms of dance, etc.).
3. List of extracurricular activities, honors and awards you would like the Scholarship Committee to consider.
4. List of fine arts teachers with whom you have studied and/or fine arts camps, classes or workshops you have attended.
5. Details of your personal goals as related to a career in the fine arts.
6. Any additional information that will help the Scholarship committee in reviewing your scholarship application.



Attachment 3 & 4: Letters of Recommendation

Applicant is required to obtain two Letters of Recommendation from individuals (i.e. teacher, art instructor, academic advisor, etc.) not related to the applicant. Each letter should address the applicant's art aptitude, potential or overall individuals accomplishments, and must be submitted directly to Boerne Performing Arts (electronically or via US Mail) no later than March 15, 2019. Be sure to provide the Boerne Performing Arts addresses (at bottom of this form) to the individuals writing your recommendations.
